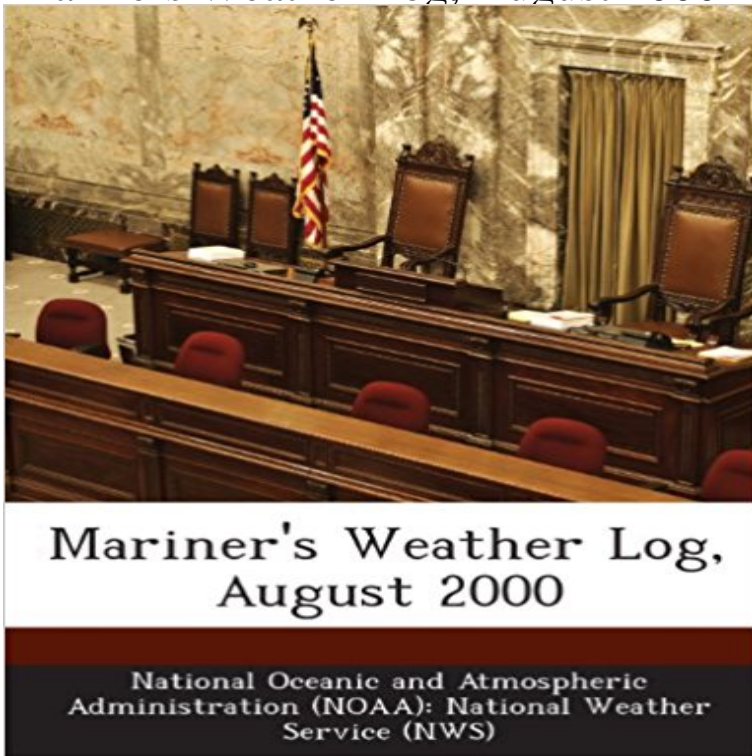


Mariners Weather Log, August 2000
