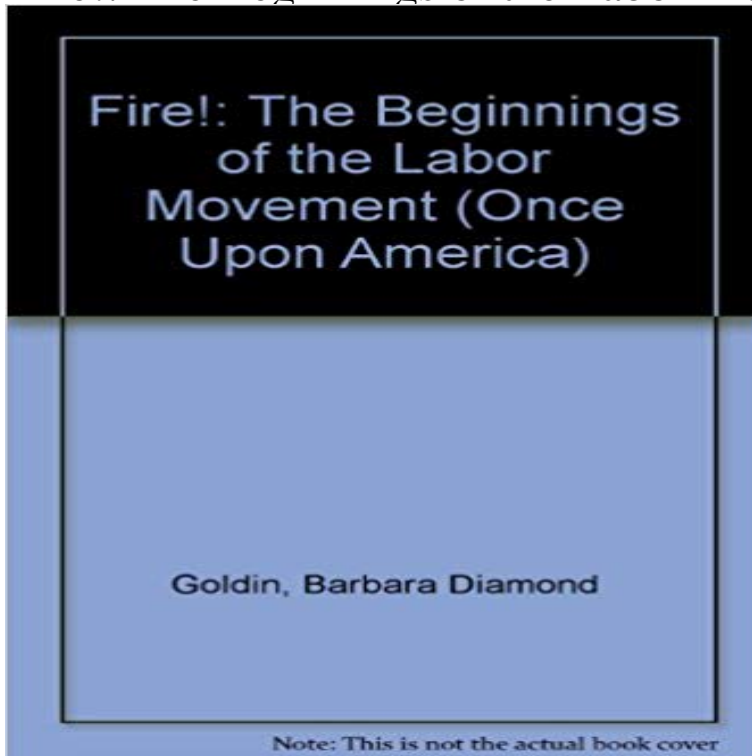


Fire!: The Beginnings of the Labor Movement (Once Upon America)
