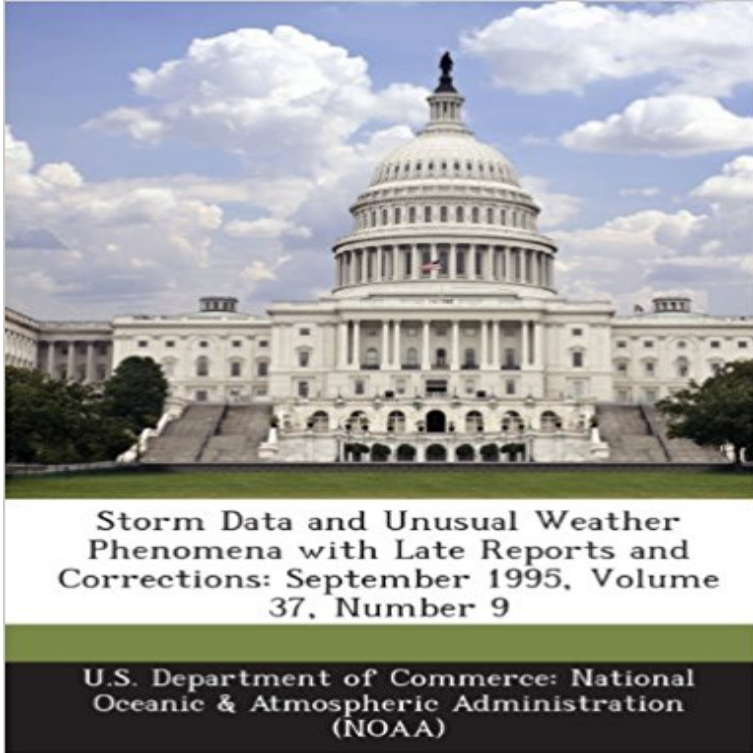


Storm Data and Unusual Weather Phenomena with Late Reports and Corrections: September 1995, Volume 37, Number 9
