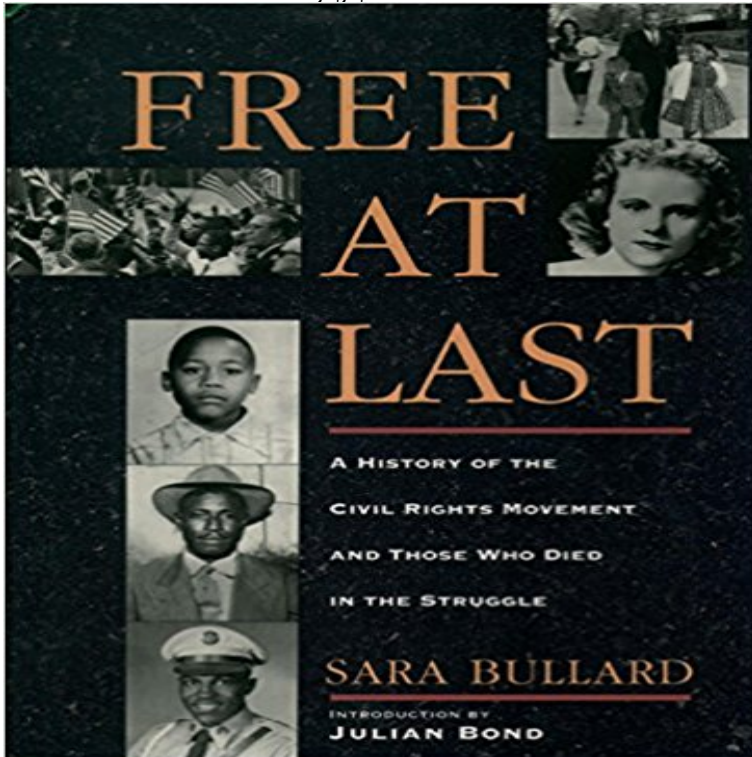


Free At Last: A History of the Civil Rights Movement and Those Who Died in the Struggle
